

Closures on State Route 32 at I-275 update

Clermont County (*Tuesday, Oct. 1, 2013*) – With the work on eastbound State Route 32 finishing a day early, work on westbound SR 32 will take place Tuesday, Oct. 1 and Wednesday, Oct. 2.

Beginning at 8 p.m. on both Tuesday, Oct. 1 and Wednesday, Oct. 2, single lane closures will be in place on westbound SR 32 at the Eastgate Boulevard Bridge. Beginning at 10 p.m. both days, westbound SR 32 will be closed from Gleneste Withamsville Road to Old SR 74 until 6 a.m. the following day. Access to I-275 will be maintained by way of Gleneste Withamsville Road to Old SR 74. The ramp from North Access Road to SR 32 will also be closed with traffic detoured to Gleneste Withamsville Road to Old SR 74 to access westbound SR 32.

Again, these closures will be in place each day from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. only.

On Thursday, Oct. 3, single lane closures will again be in place on eastbound SR 32, beginning at 8 p.m., followed by a full closure at 10 p.m.

Arrow boards and/or signs will be in place prior to the work zone to alert motorists of the upcoming lane and full closures.

To help ensure the safety of the construction workers as well as the traveling public, motorists should remain alert, reduce their speed and watch for stopped traffic while passing through the work zone.
