RE: Mt. Pisgah Road Utility Work Detour
Ohio Township

Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Section 5543.17 of the Ohio Revised Code, I have determined that a road closure is necessary on Mt. Pisgah Road, as it is impractical to construct a temporary highway, culvert, or bridge. The closure is necessary for Duke Energy to replace a utility pole.

The closure is located just north of Wilson Dunham Road on Mt. Pisgah Road. **The road will be closed to through traffic from 9AM to 2PM on Tuesday, September 29, 2026, and Wednesday, September 30, 2026.** The length of the detour is approximately 3.45 miles or 18,236 feet.

The Office of the Clermont County Engineer shall notify the Communication Center and other affected agencies. All advanced warning and detour signs will be erected and maintained for this project. The contractor will be responsible for installing and maintaining all detour signs. **Attached is the recommended detour.**
