RE: Aicholtz Road Roundabouts Utility Relocation Detour
Union Township

Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Section 5543.17 of the Ohio Revised Code, I have determined that a road closure is necessary on Aicholtz Road, as it is impractical to construct a temporary highway, culvert or bridge. Duke Energy has requested the road closure on Aicholtz Road in Union Township. The closure is needed so that Duke Energy can relocate utility poles for the upcoming Aicholtz Road Roundabouts Project.

The closure is located between address 4318 and 4336 Aicholtz Road. Eastgate Square Drive will not be accessible from Aicholtz Road during this closure. Local traffic will be maintained. **The road will be closed to through traffic from 8AM to 4PM on Monday, April 3, 2023 through Thursday, April 13, 2023.** The length of the detour is approximately 2.70 miles or 14,232 feet.

The Office of the Clermont County Engineer shall notify the Communication Center and other affected agencies. All advanced warning and detour signs will be erected and maintained for this project. The contractor will maintain the detour signs. **Attached is the recommended detour.**

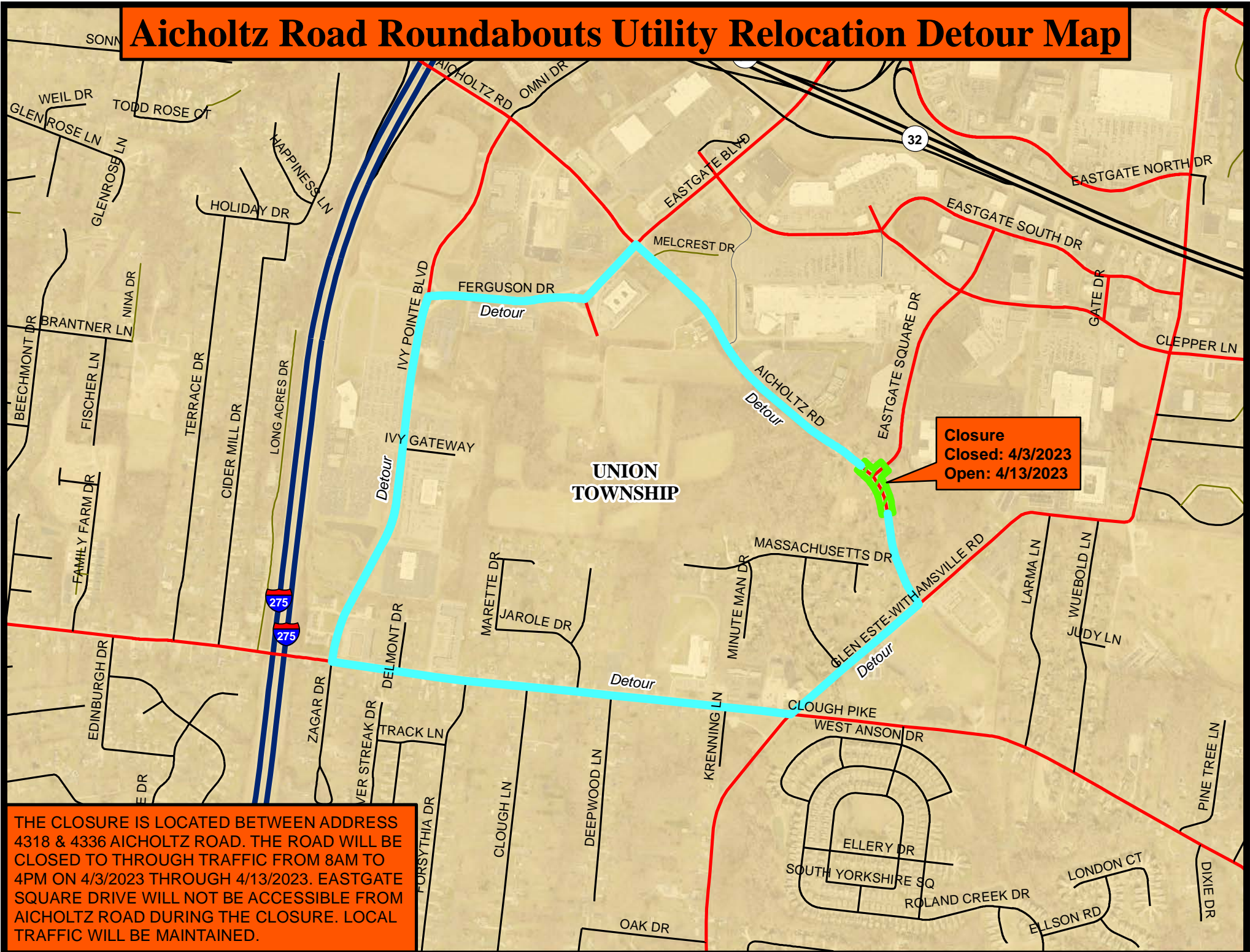
