RE: Neville Penn-Schoolhouse Road Landslide Repair Detour  
Washington Township

Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Section 5543.17 of the Ohio Revised Code, it has been determined that a road closure is necessary on Neville Penn-Schoolhouse Road, as it is impractical to construct a temporary highway, culvert, or bridge. The closure is necessary so that our contractor can repair the landslide on Neville Penn-Schoolhouse Road.

The closure is located between address 305 and 356 Neville Penn-Schoolhouse Road. **The road will be closed to through traffic beginning Monday, March 31, 2025, through Friday, April 25, 2025.** The length of the detour is approximately 11.70 miles or 61,767 feet.

The Office of the Clermont County Engineer shall notify the Communication Center and other affected agencies. All advanced warning and detour signs will be erected and maintained for this project. Our crew will install the advanced notice and detour signs. The contractor will install and maintain the barricades and closure signs at the site. **Attached is the recommended detour.**

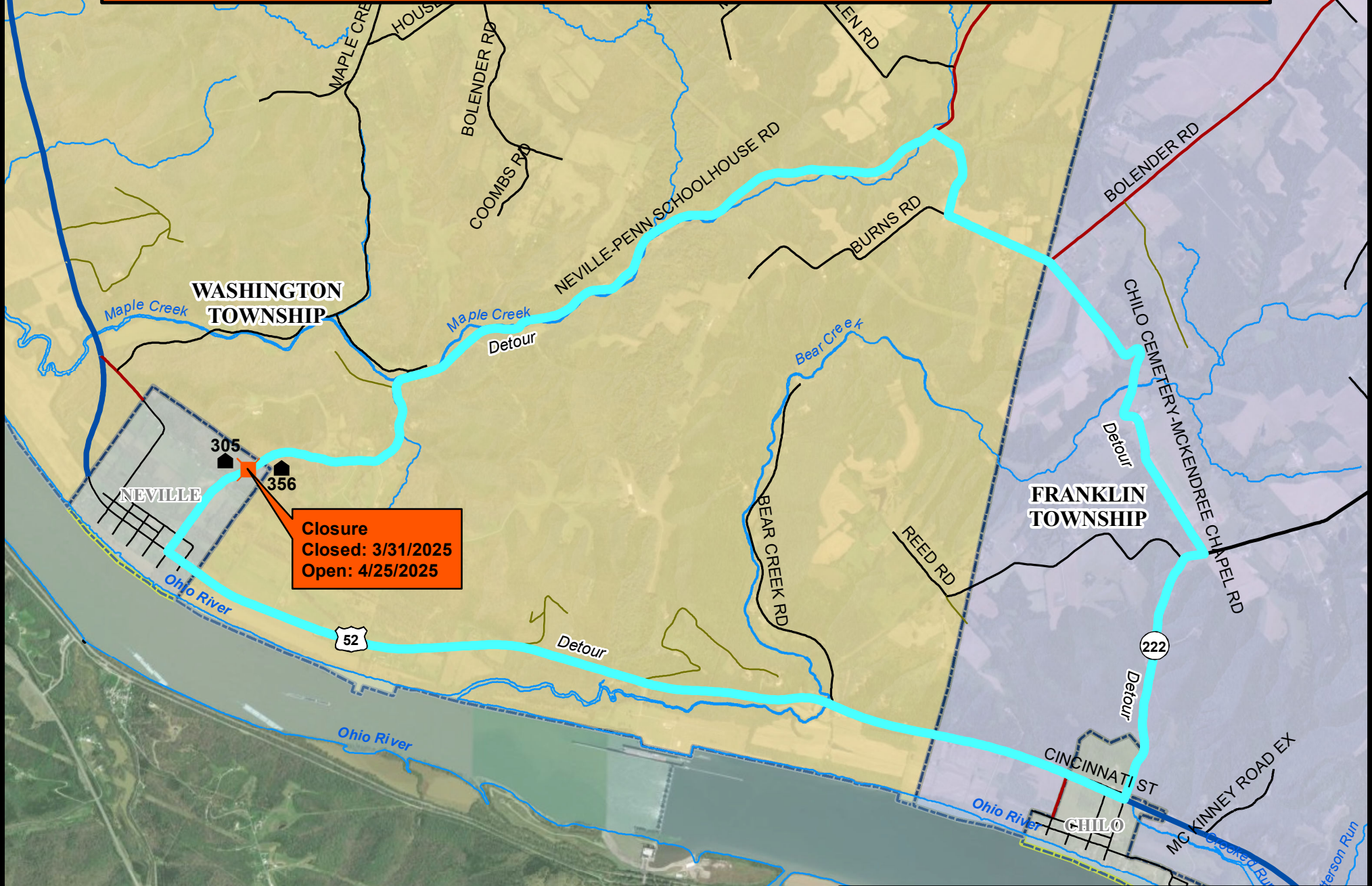
